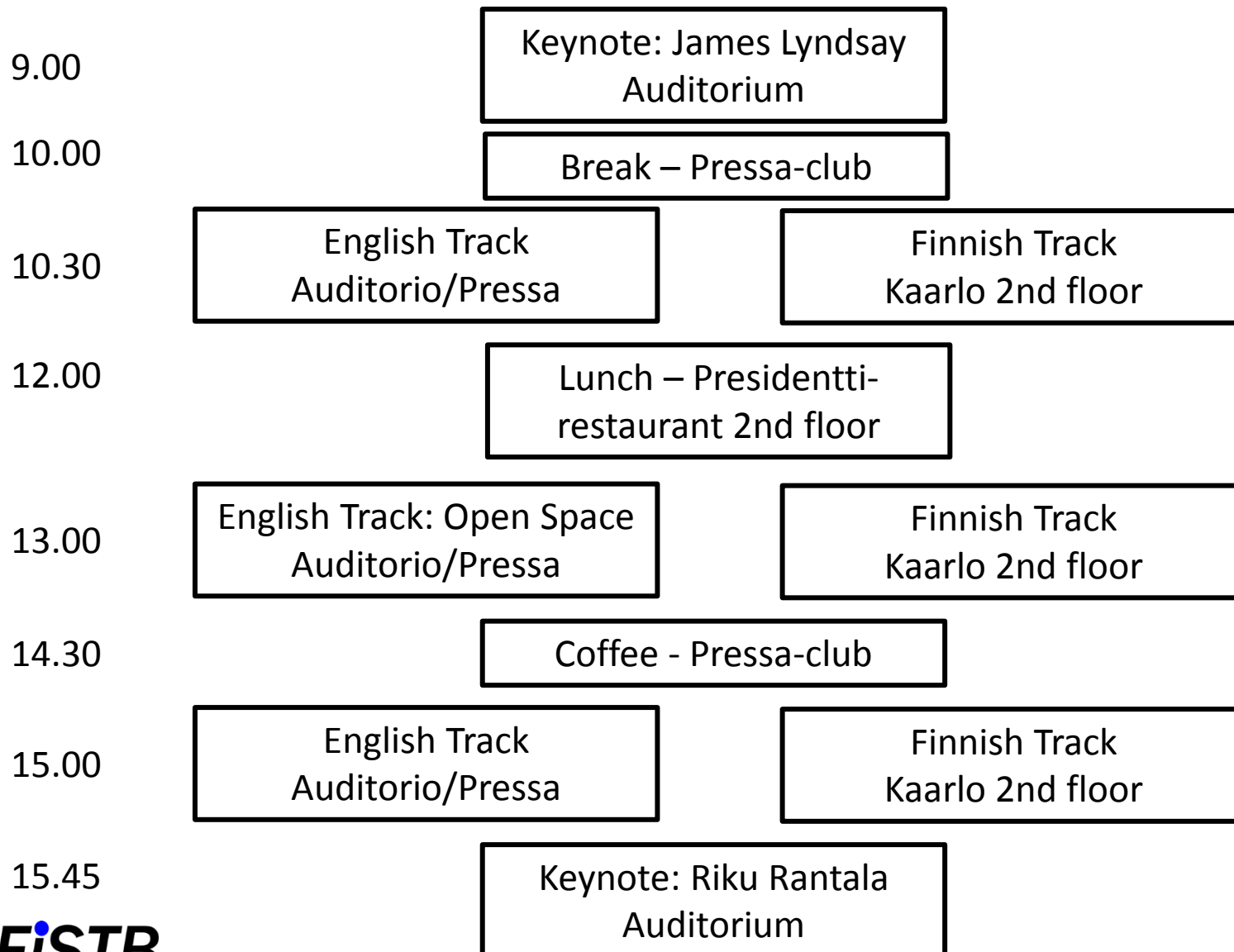

# Open Space format

- Open space is a fascinating session format where audience suggests and votes for the topics to be discussed.
